

Terms and Conditions

1. The Racing Queensland **condition of nomination**, requiring a greyhound nominated for an event at The Q to have successfully trialled out of the starting boxes to the satisfaction of QRIC stewards and/or QGRC officials, at the specific track it is to be nominated for (Q1, Q2 and/or Q Straight).

A satisfactory pre-nomination trial at The Q requires that a greyhound completes the following:

- a) Jumps from a starting box approved by Stewards/QGRC official;
- b) Runs past the finishing post; and
- c) Enters the catching pen.

(E.g.: If a greyhound has successfully trialled at only Q1 Lakeside, it is only eligible to be nominated for and compete in an event at Q1 Lakeside). *Certain events may be exempt from this condition at RQ's sole discretion.

- 2. Commissioning trial sessions will be available **free of charge** during the commissioning period of each track. Racing Queensland will advise when this commissioning period has been completed for each track and charges will then be at the distraction of the QGRC.
- 3. It is **highly recommended** that trainers provide a catcher for their trials.
- 4. Finish On Lure trials are now available on the Q1 and Q2 tracks.

Q1 Finish on trials will finish at the 550m boxesQ2 Finish on trials will finish at the 752m boxes, unless a Box to Box trial.

NO FINISH ON TRIALS ARE TO FINISH IN THE CATCHING PEN.

Trainers must provide a catcher for a finish on trial to be conducted. <u>NO</u> <u>CATCHER – NO FINSIH ON.</u>

- 5. When you arrive at your trial at the designated time (see point 6) you are to report to the QGRC staff member in the trainer's car park and await their instruction before moving to the boxes.
- Please ensure you arrive at your trial session at the designated time. If you are running late or need to cancel your trial on the day, please call the club on (07) 3862 1744 (refunds can only be granted if you cancel the club directly by phone).



- 7. Trials are conducted at the trainer's own risk. There are no vets in attendance for trials (excluding commissioned trials) and therefore RMIS is not available.
- 8. The pool is available for trainers to use for their greyhounds on trial days however is done so at the trainers' own risk.
- 9. Trainers are expected to pick up/clean up after their dogs.
- 10. Kennelling is available upon request. Speak to the Trials Supervisor when you arrive if you require a kennel.
- 11. During trials trainers have access to the following types of trials:
 - Slips
 - Box to box
 - Post to post
 - Finish on Lures (if a catcher is present)
